

Naming the Farm with Nouns

Age: 4.5-5.5 years old

Purpose: To teach children the functional word order in sentences by using concrete objects and to promote reading practice.

Directions: Introduce children to the farm. The child will select the basket of noun labels for the farm. The child will remove a noun from the basket, read it aloud, and then place it next to the appropriate object on the farm. Once the child has completed labeling the farm, tell them again that all of these words are called nouns. Ask the child if they remember which symbol represents the noun. The child will now be welcome to arrange the farm and identify the parts with the noun labels anytime.
