

Colour Box 1

Purpose: The purpose of this activity is to help the child develop visual discrimination of primary colours.

Directions: For this activity, you will invite the child to the shelf where the colour boxes are located and choose colour box 1, introducing it by name. Explain to the child how to remove the tablets holding the tablets by the wooden edge, and not touching the colour portion. Remove the tablets from the box one at a time and place them in a random order. Have the child select and match the colours red, blue and yellow.

Extensions: Colour Box 2, secondary colours, Colour box 3, shading.

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
