

## Combining Sandpaper Letters & Objects from the Sound Pouches

Purpose: The purpose of this activity is to assist the child in matching the initial sound of an object with the Sandpaper letters.

Directions: The child will lay out a mat and choose 3 Sandpaper Letters. They will position the letters across the mat and choose the corresponding Sound Pouches. They will then trace the Sandpaper Letters on the mat and pronounce the sound. Once they have pronounced the sound they can place the corresponding objects under the correct letter.

Extension: An extension of this activity would be to gather a group of students and choose 10-12 Sandpaper Letters and distribute them around the classroom. On a mat, lay out all of the objects from the corresponding Sound Pouches. Then ask a child to choose one item and find its correlating Sandpaper Letter. The children will place their letters beside their objects and then take turns naming their objects and tracing and announcing the matching letter.



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
