

## Cutting & Gluing

Purpose: for the child to recognize letters, their phonetic sound, and being able to match pictures in which the word starts with that letter.

Directions: the teacher provides the child with a piece of paper, with a letter written at the top. The child then cuts pictures out of magazines that have sounds beginning with the corresponding letter. As a final product, the child will have created a collage of pictures on their page representing that sound.

Extensions: this can be done as a group activity, or the teacher can put a word at the top of the page rather than a letter and the child can cut out pictures which rhyme with the corresponding words.
