

Large Moveable Alphabet

Purpose: To help a child progress from identifying separate sounds in a word to sentence composition.

Directions:

Introduce the child to the Large Moveable Alphabet. Place the box on the table. Ask the child to find the letters/sounds which he knows. Tell the child we are going to make some words ie: bat. Begin by asking "what is the first sound you hear when I say the word "bat"? After the child responds by saying "b" ask them to place it on the table. Proceed then with the "a" and the "t" sounds. Read the word back to the child and explain to them that they have just made the word bat.

Extensions:

Get the children to making rhyming words ie: cat, fat, mat etc.
Use three letter phonetic objects to make words.

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
