

The Hundred Board

Purpose: to provide a child with the opportunity to show mastery of sequencing numbers 1-100. While completing the hundred board the child is developing a deeper understanding of the decimal system and consolidating the understanding of numbers 1-100.

Directions: for this activity, the child is to bring the hundred board and the tile boxes to the table. The hundred board is placed on the right and the tile boxes at the top. The child will then find the tile for number 1 and place it on the board in the first square, starting in the top left-hand corner. The child then finds the tile for number 2 and places it on the board to the right of the tile for number 1. They then sequence the remaining tiles up to 10 in the same manner then start the second row with 11 and continue with the remaining tiles up to 100. When all the tiles are in place, the child then names the numbers in order from 1-100 and points at each tile as they do so. When the child has completed this, they are able to get the hundred board control chart and check their work by comparing the completed hundred board to the control chart.
